

Eugene McCray Scholarship Application

The Eugene McCray Scholarship Committee (EMSC) will award up to four annual scholarships to an African-American high school graduate and/or college undergraduate. The award recipients must provide proof of registration from the Registrar of an accredited college or trade school. The scholarship may be used for tuition or fees and must be used by May 31 of the following school year.

The EMSC will make the scholarship recipient selections. The committee is composed of the Texas Association of Black City Council Members (TABCCM). Alternate recipients will also be selected, should the primary recipient be unable to use the scholarship. Notification of the award winner will occur prior to the end of the regular school year.

To qualify, the applicant must:

1. Have a least a 2.5 average on the 4.0m scale.
2. Be an active participant in a least two extracurricular school activities.
3. Be an active participant in one or two church and civic activities.
4. Submit an application, along with an official school transcript, to the Scholarship Committee.
5. Submit a letter of recommendation from any member of TABCCM.
6. Submit a letter of recommendation from any member of the applicant's church.
7. Submit an essay on "African-Americans in Municipal Government."
8. Provide documentation of college enrollment.

The committee in the selection process will also consider financial need and extracurricular activities. In general, the committee will make the selection based on the following criteria weighting:

Grades = 40%

Financial need = 30%

Extracurricular activities (civic/church sponsored) = 20%

Extracurricular activities (school sponsored) = 10%

Applications may be submitted from April 29-May 29 each year.
