Texas Association of Black City Council Members (TABCCM) and Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) Establishes Joint Goals

- 5.) Provide seminars and workshops for HBCU students

HBCUs will assist the TABCCM with the following:

- 1.) Provide policy research as it relates to issues that affect the African-American community
- 2.) Provide juvenile crime research and statistics so that we can find ways to reach, teach and guide our youth in our respective cities
- 3.) Provide information on economic development as it relates to wealth creation so that we can grow our respective communities
