



- Prohibited from receiving gift or benefit for superior public service
 - Refuse anything that has a monetary value
 - List as CampaignContribution

Bribery

- Second Degree Felony
 - 2 to 20 years
 - ■Up to \$10,000

Prohibited from compelling threatening or forcing a public servant to perform his/her official duty, or a specific performance of his/her duty or influence them to violate their duty.

City Council Deliberations Excluded.








Improper Influence

- Prohibited from privately communicating, with the intent to influence the outcome, a public servant in an adjudicatory proceeding.
 - Municipal Court Judge
 - Municipal Court Prosecutor



Improper Influence

- Class A Misdemeanor
 - Up to 1 year in Jail
 - Up to \$4,000
 - Both







 Prohibited from accepting an honorarium in consideration for services that the public servant would not have been requested to provide but for the public servant's official position or duties





- Meals in connection with an event
- Transportation and lodging when speaking or attending a seminar
- Refuse anything that has a monetary value
- List as Campaign Contribution

- Class A Misdemeanor
 - ■Up to 1 year in Jail
 - ■Up to \$4,000
 - Both

Gift To Public Servant

 Prohibited from receiving benefit from a person subject to regulation, inspection, or investigation by the City







Exceptions

- Items with a value of \$50 or less, excluding cash and checks
- Gifts from close family and friends, if relationship is independent from your position

- Gifts from people that you have an independent business relationship with not related to your position
- Payment of expenses in the performance of your official duties
- Political contributions
- Donation of an unsolicited gift to a tax-exempt charitable organization





- Refuse anything that has a monetary value

Prohibited from, with the intent to obtain a benefit or harm another, violating a law relating to their position or misusing government property, services, personnel, or any other thing of value







- Paying City employees less than market value to perform private work for official on employee's own time
- Using City employees to perform private work during business hours
 - Reimbursing City employees for the private use of equipment or personnel





Exception

 Discounts or awards given for travel, such as frequent flyer miles, car rentals, hotel discounts, and food coupons







Abuse of Official Capacity

- Class C Misdemeanor
 - Fine up to \$500
- First Degree Felony
 - 5 to 99 years or Life
 - Up to \$10,000
 - Both

Prohibited from intentionally subjecting someone to sexual harassment






Official Oppression

Unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature, submission to which is made a term or condition of a person's exercise or enjoyment of any right, privilege, power, or immunity, either explicitly or implicitly

- Prohibited from acquiring an interest in property, deal, or business based on information that has not been made public
- Prohibited from using information that has not been made public for a nongovernmental purpose





 "Information Not Made Public" is information not generally accessible to the public and is prohibited from disclosure by the Texas Public Information Act







Misuse of Official Information Official Capacity

- Third Degree Felony
 - 2 to 10 years
 - Up to \$10,000
 - Both

- Must file an affidavit of Substantial Interest with City Secretary before any action is taken on a matter that the official has a substantial interest in
- Affidavit must be filed before any vote or decision
- Affidavit must state the nature and extent of the interest





- Cannot participate in the discussion or the vote on the matter
- "Substantial Interest" in real property is an interest in real property worth at least \$2,500








Substantial Interest

- Substantial Interest in business entity is:
 - at least 10% of the voting stock in a business; or
 - ownership of at least 10% of \$15,000 of the fair market value of a business; or
 - received 10% of their gross income for the previous year from a business

The action by the City Council must have a special economic effect on the business or property that is different than the effect it is having on other businesses or properties





 Councilmember can vote on a Budget if items where there is a conflict are voted on separately



Conflicts Disclosure Statement

Must file disclosure statement if City is going to enter into a contract with a person that has an employment or business relationship with a Councilmember or his/her spouse or child that resulted in the Councilmember or his/her spouse or child receiving more than \$2,500 in the previous 12-month period

Conflicts Disclosure Statement

 Must file disclosure if City is going to enter into a contract with a person that has given the Councilmember or the Councilmember's spouse or child gifts that total more than \$250 in the previous 12 months

- Food, lodging, transportation, or entertainment as a guest
- Political contributions
- File the disclosure statement within 7 business days after being notified by the City of a violation

 - Children
 - Siblings, Spouse's Siblings
 - Grandchildren






- Appointments in a City with less than 200 persons

- Individuals employed with the City for 6 months prior to the Councilmember being elected (Preempts City Charters and Ordinances)

Nepotism

- Class C Misdemeanor
 - Not less than \$100 and not more than \$1000
 - Removal from office
